CALL TO ORDER

The Canvassing Board meeting was called to order by Judge Kenneth Gottlieb at 1:00 p.m.

Motion to approve minutes from last Canvassing Board meeting was granted by Canvassing Board members.

BOARD TO CONSIDER, AS NEEDED

Chief Mary Hall informed the Canvassing Board members that about 24,000 Vote-by-Mail ballots have been received already and 17,000 Vote-by-Mail ballots arrived today. Chief Hall asked for permission to duplicate the Military and Overseas ballots and to tabulate Vote-by-Mail ballots that have been processed. Motion to begin duplicating and tabulation of ballots was approved by the Canvassing Board members.

Chief Hall communicated to the board the Vote-by-Mail ballot steps: from 8:30 a.m. to 9:00 a.m. is the daily ballot viewing, followed by the opening and processing of Vote-by-Mail ballots, then is tabulation of Vote-by-Mail ballots, and finally ballots are scanned through Clear Ballot System for cataloging of ballots.

There will be two buckets of ballots presented to the Canvassing Board members: Voter Intent ballots and Blank & Overvotes ballots.

Since authorization of the ballot tabulation was granted, staff may begin tabulating ballots.
