Chief Mary Hall briefed Canvassing Board members on Vote-by-Mail ballots. There are 142 Vote-by-Mail ballot envelopes with no signature, 34 Vote-by-Mail ballot envelopes with signature differ, 68 Vote-by-Mail ballot envelopes signed by other than voter, and 82 Vote-by-Mail ballots returned from voters that moved away.

- Military and Overseas Voter-by-Mail ballots were presented to the Canvassing Board members for review.
