CALL TO ORDER

The Canvassing Board meeting was called to order by Judge Kenneth Gottlieb at 11:00 a.m.

Motion to approve minutes from last Canvassing Board meeting was granted by Canvassing Board members.

BOARD TO CONSIDER VOTE-BY-MAIL BALLOTS

Chief Deputy Mary Hall briefed Canvassing Board on Early Voting and Vote-by-Mail. Approximately 445,000 Vote-by-Mail ballots were received and 337,000 people voted early. A total of about 782,000 (61%) voters have cast their vote so far. 6,500 Military and Overseas ballots have been processed. There are 175 Vote-by-Mail (VBM) ballots with no signature, 31 VBM ballots with signature differ, 51 VBM ballots signed by other than voter, 26 VBM ballots returned by voters that moved away. 140,000 Vote-by-Mail ballots were dropped off at Early Voting sites.

- (2) Blank ballots reviewed by the Canvassing Board members.
- Vote-by-Mail ballots already reviewed by the board for voter intent and duplicated were presented to Canvassing Board members to verify that ballots were duplicated correctly.
- Vote-by-Mail ballots presented to Canvassing Board members for voter intent review and guidance on how to duplicate.
