CALL TO ORDER

The Canvassing Board meeting was called to order by Judge Jill K. Levy at 1:00 p.m.

Motion to approve the minutes from the preceding meeting was granted by the Canvassing Board members.

Chief Deputy Mary Hall told Canvassing Board members that the Post-Election Audit will be demonstrated through a new process. Kevron Aird explained that the Election Night report will be compared with the Clear Ballot results by the Canvassing Board. If there is a discrepancy, then a reconciliation will need to be done. Motion to use Clear Ballot System for the Election Audit was granted by the Canvassing Board members. Vote-by-Mail Audit results was presented to the Canvassing Board members for review. Motion to accept Vote-by-Mail results was granted by the Canvassing Board members. Election Day results presented to the Canvassing Board members for review. There is a discrepancy on (1) vote which is due to the way voter voted (bubbling on ballot, precinct W016). Additional documentation provided. Motion to accept additional documentation of the audit granted by the Canvassing Board members. Motion to accept the Election Day Audit results was granted by the Canvassing Board members. Motion to accept and sign the Post-Election Report was approved by Canvassing Board members.
