(16) UOCAVA (Simulus Duplication) and (2) UOCAVA (NOVUS Duplication) Vote-by-Mail ballots reviewed by the Canvassing Board members. Motion that all UOCAVA ballots were duplicated correctly was granted by the Canvassing Board members.
