MEETING CONVENED: 2:00 P.M.

Meeting was called to order by Judge Florence Taylor Barner at 2:00 p.m. Participating at this time was Judge Florence Taylor Barner, Supervisor of Elections Joe Scott, and Broward Mayor Michael Udine. Motion to approve minutes from the preceding Canvassing Board meeting was granted by the board.

Chief Deputy Mary Hall will be presenting to the Canvassing Board members the different Vote-by-Mail (VBM) ballots to be reviewed today.

(102) Voter Intent VBM Ballots – presented to Canvassing Board members for their review and determination. Board reviewed and gave a motion on every Voter Intent VBM ballots.

10 minutes recess – Canvassing Board members reconvened at 3:14 p.m. and continued with the reviewing of Voter Intent VBM ballots. Motion to duplicate ballots and have them available for Public Inspection was granted by the Canvassing Board members.

(1,136) pages 3 and 4 that are blank – Canvassing Board members were asked permission for blank pages to be available for Public Inspection and to bring any of those pages questioned by observers to the board for review. And, for this process to continue throughout the election. Board agreed with request.

(219) UOCAVA Duplicated Ballots – Military and Overseas ballots received via fax are duplicated, and then presented to the Canvassing Board members to verify that duplication

was done correctly. Motion for a separate time to be scheduled with Judge Barner to come in and review duplicate ballots, and then for duplicated ballots to be made available for Public Inspection was granted by the board. Duplicated VBM ballots will be reviewed by Canvassing Board members today, but moving forward it will be done as agreed by the board. Motion that Military and Overseas ballots were duplicated properly and for ballots to be made available for Public Inspection was granted by the Canvassing Board members.

(52) Duplicated Sets of VBM Ballots –duplicated ballots presented to the Canvassing Board members for review. All VBM ballots reviewed today will be available for Public Inspection on Wednesday, October 19th due to the Groundbreaking event of the new SOE building being held tomorrow morning. It was emphasized that any Voter Intent VBM ballot needs to be brought to the Canvassing Board members for review first. Motion that all ballots were duplicated properly was granted by the Canvassing Board members. (3) Duplicated VBM ballots need to be duplicated again and brought to the Canvassing Board members for review.

(63) Overvotes VBM Ballots – presented for review. Motion that all ballots are Overvotes and to be available for Public Inspection was granted by the board. (1) ballot needs to be duplicated.

(7) VBM ballots protested during Public Inspection by observers presented to Canvassing Board members for review.
