MEETING CONVENED: 10:00 A.M.

Meeting was called to order by Judge Betsy Benson at 10:00 a.m. Participating at this time was Judge Betsy Benson and Supervisor of Elections Joe Scott. Broward Mayor Lamar Fisher is arriving later.

Chief Deputy Mary Hall welcomed members of the audience and introduced Kevron Aird who gave a brief outline of the logic and Accuracy Test. There will be (10) DS200s and (6) DS850s tested today during the Logic and Accuracy Test. Test Script was provided to Canvassing Board members. Zero tapes presented to the Canvassing Board members for their review. Motion that all machines are zeroed out and ready to proceed with the Logic and Accuracy Test was granted by the present Canvassing Board members. It was mentioned that ballots are marked based on Test Script provided to the board. Results of the Logic and Accuracy Test was presented to the Canvassing Board for review. Permission granted by the present Canvassing Board members to zero out machines.

Motion to recess for 15 minutes was granted by the present Canvassing Board members. Back in session at 10:35 a.m. Mayor Lamar Fisher had arrived at the Canvassing Board meeting.

Motion to approve the results of the Logic and Accuracy Test and that the test was completed successfully was granted by the Canvassing Board members.

Motion to authorize the processing of Vote-by-Mail (VBM) ballots after the completion of the Logic and Accuracy Test, and the opening, tabulation, and duplication of VBM ballots subject to Public Inspection (beginning February 22nd) was granted by the Canvassing Board members. Motion to approve the Guidelines and Procedures for the Conduct of Board Meetings, Observer and Public Participation at Meeting was granted by Canvassing Board members.

Zero tape presented to the Canvassing Board members for review. Motion to shut down machines and seal equipment (DS200s) was granted by the Canvassing Board members.
