MEETING CONVENED: 3:00 P.M.

The meeting was called to order by Judge Nina W. Di Pietro at 6:30 p.m. Participating at this time was Judge Nina W. Di Pietro, Supervisor of Elections Joe Scott, and County Commissioner Michael Udine (Alternate for Mayor Nan H. Rich).

Motion to approve the Canvassing Board meeting minutes from the preceding meeting was granted by the Canvassing Board members.

Chief Deputy Mary Hall presented the following ballot categories to the Canvassing Board members:

- (6) Voter Intent (pre-canvass) ballots provided to the board for determination. The board gave a motion on each ballot. Motion to duplicate and tabulate ballots was granted by the Canvassing Board members.
- (10) Voter Intent (post-canvass) ballots with duplicates provided to the board for reviewing. Motion to approve duplicated ballots, and to tabulate them was granted by the Canvassing Board members.
- (5) Duplicated ballot sets presented to the Canvassing Board members for review. Motion that ballots were duplicated properly, and to tabulate them was granted by the board.
- (1) Blank ballot – motion that ballot is blank was granted by the board.

- (2) Overvote ballots – motion that the ballots are overvotes, and to tabulate them was granted by the board.
- (6) UOCAVA ballots presented to the Canvassing Board members for their review. Motion that ballots were duplicated accurately, and to tabulate them was granted by the board.

Vote-by-Mail ballots stored in a blue bag with seal # 0366917.

- (1) VBM ballot with cure affidavit presented to the board for review. Motion to approve the ballot was granted by the Canvassing Board members.
- Ballot from a voter who moved to Martin County, and which was previously presented to the Canvassing Board members. Motion to reject since voter is a Martin County resident was granted by the board.
- A voter changed his/her address within Broward County and voted in the wrong precinct. Motion to reject ballot based on the law was granted by the board.

- (6) Voter intent ballots previously reviewed by the board were duplicated and presented to the board for review. Motion that ballots were properly duplicated, and to tabulate them was granted by the Canvassing Board members.
