MEETING CONVENED: 4:00 P.M.

The meeting was called to order by Judge Giuseppina Miranda at 4:00 p.m. In attendance were Judge Giuseppina Miranda, County Commissioner Lamar P. Fisher and Mayor Nan H. Rich.

A motion to approve the minutes from the previous Canvassing Board meeting, held on August 22nd was granted by the board.

At the last Canvassing Board meeting, legal counsel Devona Reynolds Perez informed the Canvassing Board members about a voter who had satisfied all judgments and regained the right to vote. The provisional ballot from this voter was presented to the board today. The board approved the provisional ballot and recessed to allow time for the Supervisor of Elections (SOE) staff to process the ballot.

Motion to recess at 4:04 p.m. and to reconvene at 4:15 p.m. was granted by the board.

Upon reconvening, since staff was still unavailable, the board went off record for another 10 minutes. A motion to recess at 4:15 p.m. and reconvene at 4:25 p.m. was granted by the board.

Back on record, the SOE staff is communicating with the state about uploading final results today. Motion to recess at 4:26 p.m. and to reconvene at 4:40 p.m. was granted by the board.

Back on record, staff needs more time to provide the results. Motion to recess at 4:40 p.m. and to reconvene at 4:50 p.m. was granted by the board.

Back on record, the board compared the final results certificate against the data results prepared by the staff and signed documents.

The Post-Election Automated Independent Audit was conducted and completed. All precincts and races were audited. The board observed the audit, and the audit results were presented for their review. The board approved the audit results and signed.
