GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS
Shall bonds of Pembroke Pines in an aggregate principal amount not exceeding \$230,000,000 be issued in multiple series maturing not later than 30 years from their date, bearing interest at a rate not exceeding the maximum lawful rate determined at time of sale, and payable from unlimited ad valorem taxes, to provide funds to construct and improve a police - public safety complex, community facilities, recreational facilities, roadway and infrastructure improvements, and land acquisition.
