Authorization for the Commencement of Canvassing and Public Inspection, on or after October 1, 2026, including the Processing, Opening, Tabulation, and Duplication of Vote-by-Mail Ballots, pursuant to §§101.68 and 102.141, Florida Statutes (subject to the completion of the L&A Test); and Designate Alternates for the Supervisor of Elections to be present for Ballot Processing, Opening, Tabulation, and Duplication, in the event of the Supervisor of Elections’ temporary absence.
