MEETING CONVENED:

5:00 P.M.

The meeting was called to order by Judge Jennifer Hilal at 5:00 p.m. In attendance were Judge Jennifer Hilal, County Vice Mayor Robert McKinzie, and Supervisor of Elections Joe Scott.

Pledge of Allegiance

A motion to approve the minutes from the previous meeting was made and approved by the board members.

Scott Andron and Devona Reynolds Perez reviewed the Voter Intent PowerPoint presentation with the board members.

After the presentation, Chief Deputy Mary Hall presented the following ballot categories to the Canvassing Board members.

Five (5) ballots were presented to the Canvassing Board members for their review and determination. Herman Schnell from the Republican Party addressed the board regarding a ballot with writing on it. The Supervisor of Elections (SOE) clarified that the writing represented the voter's initials. A motion to duplicate the ballots was approved by the Canvassing Board members.

One (1) overvote ballot was presented for review. The board agreed that the ballot contained an overvote. A motion to duplicate the overvote ballot and tabulate it was approved by the Canvassing Board members.

Eleven (11) blank ballots were presented to the Canvassing Board members for review and confirmation. A motion confirming that all ballots were blank and should be tabulated as such was approved by the Canvassing Board members.

Four (4) duplicated ballot sets were presented to the board for confirmation. A motion confirming that all four ballot sets were duplicated accurately was approved by the board members.

Three (3) UOCAVA ballots were duplicated and presented to the board for confirmation. A motion confirming that all UOCAVA ballots were duplicated accurately and should be tabulated was approved by the board members.

Vote-by-Mail (VBM) ballots stored in a bag with seal #0391779 were presented to the board for review and approval.

Seven (7) VBM ballots with signature differences were presented to the board for determination. A motion to reject six VBM ballots and approve one VBM ballot was approved by the board members.

Three (3) VBM ballots from voters who responded to the office with a cure affidavit were presented to the board. A motion confirming that all three ballots were properly cured and that the voters provided the appropriate documentation with the cure affidavit was approved by the board members.

A motion to recess at 6:00 p.m. for one hour was approved by the board.

The meeting resumed after recess. Voter intent ballots that had already been duplicated were provided to the board for review. A motion confirming that the ballots were duplicated accurately and were ready to be tabulated was approved by the board members.

A motion to recess until 8:00 p.m. was approved by the board.

The meeting resumed at 8:00 p.m. The Canvassing Board members then went into recess until 8:30 p.m.

At 8:07 p.m., Ms. Hall announced that all Vote-by-Mail ballots had been received and were in the building.
