MEETING CONVENED: 10:00 A.M.

The meeting was called to order by Judge Jennifer Hilal at 10:00 a.m. In attendance were Judge Jennifer Hilal, County Vice Mayor Robert McKinzie, and Supervisor of Elections Joe Scott.

Pledge of Allegiance

A motion to approve the minutes from the previous meeting was made and approved by the Canvassing Board members.

Chief Deputy Mary Hall presented Vote-by-Mail (VBM) ballots to the Canvassing Board members for their review.

Two (2) VBM ballots with no voter signature were presented to the Board. A motion to reject the VBM ballots was made and approved by the Canvassing Board members.

One (1) VBM ballot with a cure affidavit but no identification was presented to the Board for review. A motion to approve the VBM ballot was made and approved by the Canvassing Board members. A motion to open and tabulate the ballot was also approved by the Board members.

Chief Deputy Hall explained to the Board that one VBM ballot had been received with no ballot enclosed.

Benjamin Williams presented one (1) provisional ballot cast on Election Day to the Canvassing Board members. The voter had moved into Broward County and voted in the correct precinct. The ballot was stored in a bag with seal #0881513. A motion to approve, open, and tabulate the provisional ballot was made and approved by the Board members.

A motion to recess for 15 minutes was made and approved by the Board at 10:09 a.m.

The meeting reconvened, and the Canvassing Board members reviewed the final numbers and signed the official summary report for the March 10, 2026 Municipal Elections.

The system audit process was presented by Kevron Aird, who explained that the two reports generated from two different systems reflected the same numbers.
