**MEETING CONVENED: 10:00 A.M.**

The meeting was called to order by Judge Kenneth Gottlieb at 10:15 a.m. Present were Judge Kenneth Gottlieb, County Vice Mayor Robert McKinzie, and Supervisor of Elections Joe Scott.

Pledge of Allegiance

Chief Deputy Mary Hall welcomed the Canvassing Board members and called upon Kevron Aird, Election Systems Manager, to address the Board. Mr. Aird explained that the following equipment would be tested: six (6) Election Day DS200 scanners, four (4) DS850 scanners, two (2) ExpressVote machines, and four (4) Fujitsu FI-7900 scanners.

The Board reviewed the zero tapes and confirmed that all machines had been properly zeroed. A motion confirming that all tapes had been reviewed and that the machines were zeroed prior to the Logic and Accuracy (L&A) Test was approved by the Board. A motion to commence the L&A Test was also approved.

Judge Gottlieb asked Chief Deputy Mary Hall to discuss Item #6 on the agenda. Chief Deputy Hall informed the Board that 358 Vote-by-Mail ballots had been mailed for the special election

and that 74 voted Vote-by-Mail ballots had been returned. Public inspection of ballots will begin on June 18, 2026. A motion to approve the commencement of canvassing and public inspection, including the processing, opening, tabulation, and duplication of Vote-by-Mail ballots, was approved by the Board. The Chair announced that Supervisor of Elections Joe Scott, in his capacity as a member of the Canvassing Board, would be present for the opening, processing, tabulation, and duplication of Vote-by-Mail ballots. The Chair further announced that, if Supervisor Scott were unable to be present temporarily during that process, designated deputies appointed as alternates from the Supervisor of Elections Office would serve solely in Supervisor Scott's place as member of the Canvassing Board during any such temporary absence. It was noted that these designated deputies would not be participating in Canvassing Board deliberations or as an alternate for any other Canvassing Board member while serving in place of Supervisor Scott. The names of the designated alternates that were provided are: Thea Jones, Charlotte Shipman-Smith, Latrice Lamar, Lillie Yon, Roosevelt Watts, and Chief Deputy Supervisor of Elections Mary Hall. Chief Deputy Mary Hall was designated as the primary alternate to serve in place of Supervisor Scott as a member of the Canvassing Board during Supervisor Scott's absence.

A motion to approve the Guidelines and Procedures for Observers and Canvassing Board Meetings was approved by the Board.

The Board discussed the meeting time for June 23, 2026. A start time of 6:30 p.m. was proposed and approved by the Board members. The meeting scheduled for June 26, 2026, will begin at 1:30 p.m.

The Board recessed at 10:27 a.m.

Upon reconvening, Kevron Aird presented the DS200 and DS850 test results to the Board. The Board reviewed the results and confirmed that they matched the test script. A motion to accept the test results and certify the successful completion of the L&A Test was approved by the Board.

The L&A Test Summary Report and Clear Ballot Audit Report were provided to the Board members for review and signature. Following certification of the successful test results, a motion authorizing staff to clear and re-zero all machines was approved by the Board.

Zero reports and tapes were then presented to the Board for review to confirm that all machines had been returned to zero. A motion confirming that all machines had been successfully zeroed was approved. A motion to close and seal the machines was also approved.

A motion to store all L&A materials in a clear bin and secure them with seals numbered 1383414 and 1383415 was approved by the Board.
