MEETING CONVENED: 6:30 P.M.

The meeting was called to order by Judge Kenneth Gottlieb at 6:30 p.m. Present were Judge Kenneth Gottlieb, County Vice Mayor Robert McKinzie, and Supervisor of Elections Joe Scott.

Pledge of Allegiance

A motion to approve the minutes from the previous Canvassing Board meeting was made and approved by the Board.

Judge Gottlieb noted that there was no need for a voter intent presentation. The Board members agreed.

Chief Deputy Mary Hall presented one (1) ballot requiring a voter intent determination for the Board's review. A motion regarding the voter's intent was approved by the Board. A motion to duplicate the ballot and return it to the Board for confirmation that the duplication was completed correctly was also approved.

One (1) damaged ballot was duplicated and presented to the Board for review. A motion confirming that the ballot was duplicated correctly was approved by the Board.

One (1) UOCAVA ballot was received, duplicated, and presented to the Board for review. A motion confirming that the ballot was properly reproduced and ready for tabulation was approved by the Board.

A motion to schedule the next Canvassing Board meeting for Thursday, June 25, 2026, at 5:00 p.m. was approved by the Board.

The duplicated voter intent ballot was presented to the Board for review. A motion confirming that the ballot was duplicated correctly was approved by the Board.

One (1) ballot that did not process through the DS850 machine required Board review. A motion regarding the voter's intent and authorization to duplicate the ballot was approved by the Board.

The Board waited for the election results, which will be released after 7:00 p.m.

The duplicated ballot was presented to the Board for review. A motion confirming that the ballot was duplicated correctly was approved by the Board.

A motion to recess the meeting at 6:52 p.m. for 15 minutes was approved by the Board.

The Canvassing Board reconvened following the recess. Unofficial election results were presented to the Board members for review and signature.
