The Broward County Canvassing Board will convene at the Supervisor of Elections’ Office, located at **4650 NW 21st Avenue, Fort Lauderdale, FL 33309** at the dates and times listed below for the purposes of preparing for, conducting, and tabulating the results of the General Election, to be held on Tuesday, November 3, 2026. Wednesday, 9/30/26 10:00 am to conclusion	– Canvassing Board to convene for the public Logic & Accuracy Test of the voting and tabulating equipment to be used for Vote-by-Mail, Early Voting, and Election Day ballots; to authorize the opening, processing, duplication, and tabulation of Vote-by-Mail ballot envelopes after the conclusion of the Logic & Accuracy Test. – Canvassing Board to consider procedures regarding the conduct of meetings, signature and ballot material inspections, and public participation. – Canvassing Board to review sample ballots and consider procedures for questions of voter intent.

Friday, 11/06/2026 9:00 a.m. to conclusion	– Canvassing Board to continue canvassing and review, as needed: ▪ Challenges/Protests ▪ Determinations of Voter Intent ▪ Duplicated ballots ▪ Duplicated Overseas & Military ballots. ▪ Blank ballots, undervotes, overvotes ▪ Provisional ballots ▪ Cure Affidavits ▪ Ballots without a voter certificate ▪ Envelopes with multiple ballots ▪ Envelopes without a ballot ▪ Deceased voter ballots ▪ Any other relevant matter – Report First Unofficial Election Results (deadline to complete 11/07/26 by noon). – At or after 5:00 p.m. - Order recount(s) for municipal and/or county elections, if necessary. – Discuss any recounts called in federal, state, and multicounty races.
Friday, 11/06/26 9:00 am to conclusion	– Logic & Accuracy Test of tabulation machines for any recounts ordered – Conduct ordered machine and/or manual recount(s) (if any).
Thursday, 11/12/26 9:00 am until conclusion	– Complete manual recount, if necessary – Report Second Unofficial Election Results, if machine recount was conducted (deadline to file 11/12/26 by 3:00 pm).
Monday, 11/16/26 9:00 am to conclusion	– Certification of Official Election Results (by noon). – Conduct Post-Election Automated Independent Audit, if no manual recount is conducted (must be completed and published by 11:59 pm on 11/23/26). To be noticed at least 48 hours prior to the meeting.
Tuesday, 11/17/26	The Elections Canvassing Commission shall meet at 8 a.m. on the 14th day after a general election to certify the returns of the election for each federal, state, and multicounty office and for each constitutional amendment.
